Finally, our 1,000th Parade and our New Shirt Committees are still finalizing those projects. As for the 1,000th Parade observance, I won't pass along any further information for now until that is finalized, in case some details change. And as for new polo shirts, it looks like we're getting much closer to a final main design, but some technical details need to be worked out to get them ready for us. Thanks to everyone involved for their work on those projects. That's about it for now.

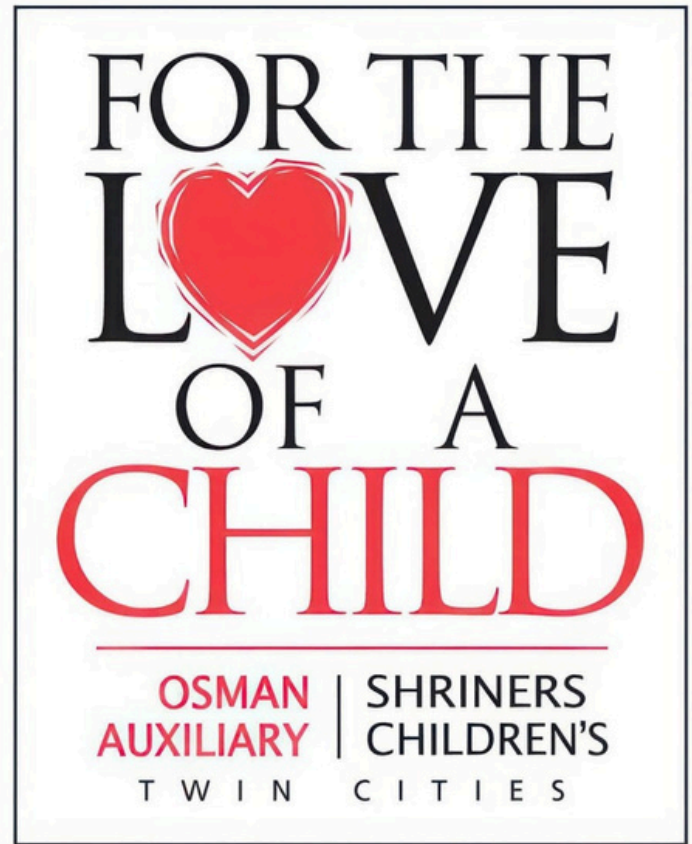
Warm Greetings to all our Osman Auxiliary members and Friends,

Getting to Know the Osman Shrine - a Brief History in Review

On August 23, 1913 Osman Temple St. Paul conducted a "Canal Zone Pilgrimage" via the United Fruit Company Steamship Service to the Panama Canal. This was a 2 week journey on the S.S. Turrialba sailing around the Panama Canal, regions of Panama, and the Caribbean Sea ending the cruise in New Orleans on September 8, 1913. It appears to have been very well attended by 30 members of the Temple. The "Pilgrims" returned to St. Paul via Train arriving at Union Station to a welcoming committee of "The Sheiks, 16 in number mounted on gaily caparisoned horses, clad in beautiful flowing robes, a Band of 30 members attired as canal laborers, a patrol, the Divan, the Band which accompanied the pilgrimage, about 100 members of the Temple on foot, and about 30 automobiles filled with members.

Zuhrah's Band, Patrol, and a large number of Zuhrah Nobles materially helped in the welcome." The procession marched from Union Depot to the Osman Temple where an informal reception, lunch, and a "general Love feast" ensued.

This pilgrimage laid the groundwork for the future formation of our sister Temple (Abou Saad) in Panama with Osman Nobility holding a formal ceremonial initiation on September 1, 1913 in the west chamber of the Mira Flores Locks during the pilgrimage. The ceremony initiated 171 members to Abou Saad Temple 25 feet below sea level. IS Samuel Marcuse was their first potentate serving 1918 - 1919. Their Temple was officially chartered in 1918 (delayed due to World War I.)
