Before I get into the fun activities of Osman Shrine, I would like to address questions and concerns that have been brought to my attention in reference to the insurance requirements for Osman Shrine parading.

I want to provide clarification on the required parade waiver. I understand that some units have questions about the waivers and a lot of misinformation is being spread to parade unit officers. Our insurance company has required, as a condition of them providing us with insurance, all parade participants (whether driving or walking) to sign the waiver. This waiver was reviewed by our temple attorney who found no concerns with the language of the waiver. The waiver is between you and our insurance carrier for injuries to yourself.

This insurance policy is a liability policy intended to protect Osman Shrine Temple from damages caused to other people (ie. the public) and property from our parade vehicles. It is very similar to the liability coverage you have on your own insurance policies which protect you from damages you cause to others (not to yourself). The waiver does not shift the liability of those damages to the Noble operating the vehicle

At the same time, the insurance policy does not provide specific coverage to our own Nobles who are injured while parading in Osman owned parade equipment. You would want to check your own insurance policies if you are concerned about whether they would cover you while you are parading for Osman Shrine. We cannot give you advice about what your own insurance does or does not cover.

We take the requirement of this waiver by our insurance carrier very seriously. Parading without signing the waiver is a breach of our contract with our insurance carrier. If it is discovered that a unit performs in any parade with a person that did not provide a waiver, I will ground that unit for the remainder of the parade season. The vehicles, any tow vehicle and trailer will be stored at the warehouse location in Eagan. We cannot afford to have any single unit risk our insurance policy.

I appreciate everyone's understanding and compliance with the requirements of our insurance policy. There are very few carriers who insure Shrine parading units. If we cannot get insurance in the future, our ability to parade will be severely limited.

As you may already know, Osman Shriners having fun and building fellowship is one of my top priorities for 2026. And, this was not lost on the Feast of Fools event. If you attended the annual Feast of Fools Potentate Roast, you experienced first-hand the exceptional effort the St. Cloud Shrine Club put forth to create the comedy and skits that kept all the attendees in stitches! I really had an awesome time, even though I was the target of the roasting! Kathy Flicek was phenomenal in roasting me, although Laurie received as much roasting as I did from her! Just, “Ask Laurie because she knows everything!” If you were not there, feel free to ask either Laurie or Kathy to fill you in. If you have never experienced the Feast of Fools Roasting of the Potentate, I recommend you make it a priority in the future. If you have, and thought it was too harsh of humor, please give it another try. The guys kept it hysterically funny and family friendly, and it was truly an outstanding event!

By the time the May issue of The Osman is available, Laurie and I will have attended the WGA for Kids Banquet. We have attended this banquet in the past, and it is always very informative event about the current happenings at Shriners Children’s Twin Cities. 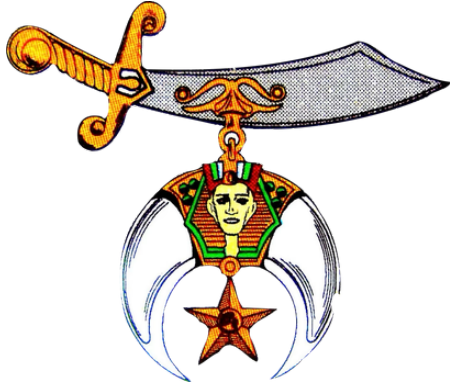

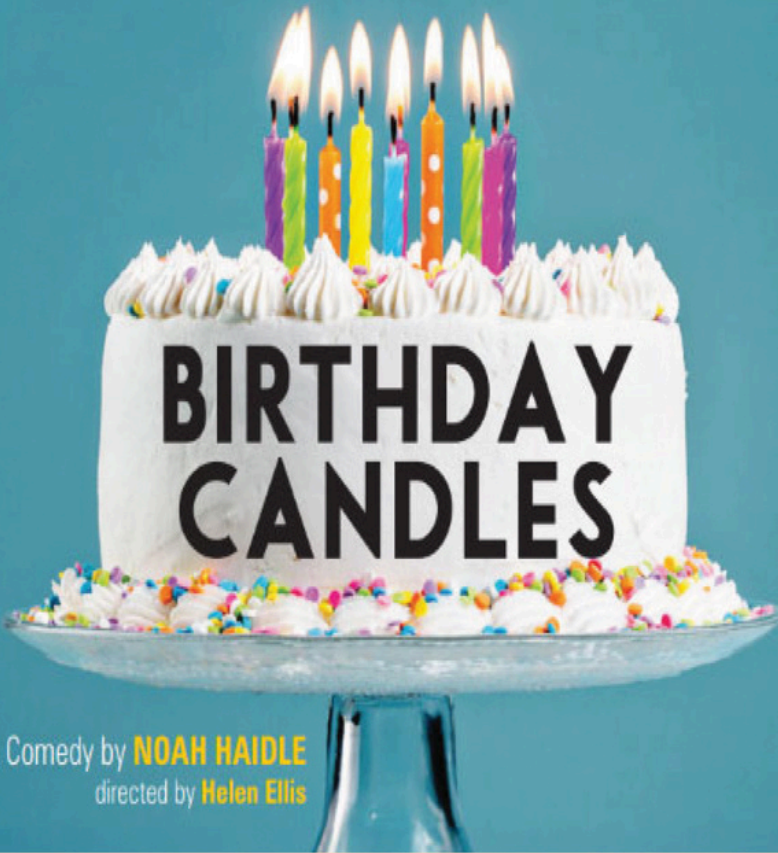

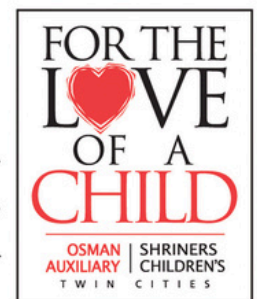

Warm Greetings to all our Osman Auxiliary members and Friends,

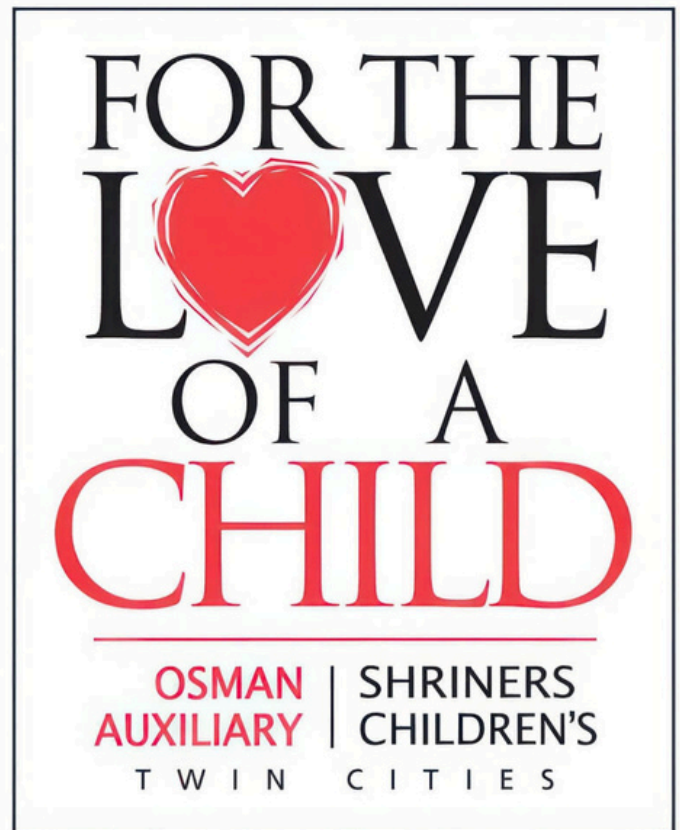

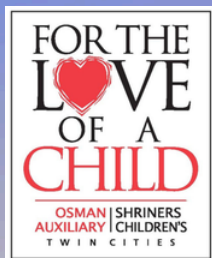

Getting to Know the Osman Shrine - a Brief History in Review

Illustrious Noble William J Florence entered the Unseen Temple on November 20th, 1891. By his death Osman Temple has lost its most distinguished member, for he was the founder of the Order on this Hemisphere.

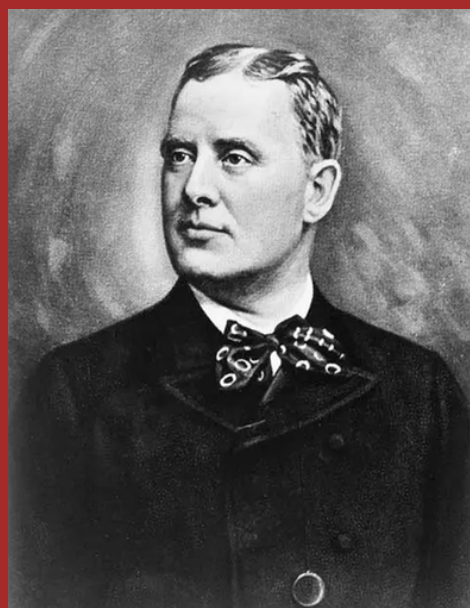
He was probably more widely known than any other Noble of the Mystic Shrine, and was universally beloved; indeed, he had the esteem and affection of all men whose privilege it was to know him.

By his accomplishments as an actor he had contributed much to the happiness of his fellows. The announcement of his death cast a deeper gloom over his many friends here, because at the very time when he lay upon his death bed in Philadelphia, we had expected to welcome him among us.

* Closed forever are the lips which late were so ready with wit and anecdote; nevermore shall we see his genial smile or hear his cheerful greeting. Long shall we remember him, and sincerely mourn for him as a kind and estimable gentleman, a most accomplished actor and a true Noble, whose escutcheon is clean; whose memory leaves no stain. May he have rest in Peace.

*The prophesy of the play-bill has been verified, and it was indeed the "last tour" of the Jefferson-Florence Company.

According to Shriner's International, William Jermyn Conlin (a.k.a., William J "Billy" Florence) is credited as the co-founder of the Ancient Arabic Order of the Nobles of the Mystic Shrine, along with Walter M. Fleming, M.D.



William and Walter would meet for lunch at the Knickerbocker Cottage in Manhattan at a special second floor table to discuss the idea of a new fraternity for Masons, stressing fun and fellowship. William in his travels as actor recounted his experience as a guest of a party given by an Arab diplomat where he witnessed a musical comedy that at its conclusion, guests would become members to a secret society. Florence took copious notes from this event, as well as, his travels to Algiers and Cairo. This would be the nidus for the formation of the Ancient Arabic Order of the Nobles of the Mystic Shrine. Fleming, in reviewing Florence's notes, created the ritual, emblem, and costumes. They were initiated into the Mecca Shrine August 13, 1870 and they initiated 11 men on June 16, 1871.

William attended many Osman Temple functions as a visiting noble from Mecca Temple in New Jersey. On November 10th, 1886 when he was extended honorary membership status in Osman Temple and returned frequently to the meetings and events until his death.

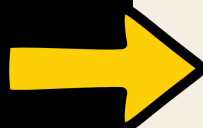
